The much-awaited day has arrived when our children will step on the threshold of Edu space. To have the smooth sailing of this journey of learning here are a **few important guidelines for parents.**

1. As for the child to blend to the new surroundings you are requested to send him/her on Tuesday, April 1, 2025 between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. You are required to drop and pick your child.

2. School Buses will ply at 11:15 a.m., parents availing school transport are requested to come at 11a.m. to accompany school transport to see bus routes.
3. Commencement of new session is from Thursday, April 3, 2025.
4. Regular School Timings are 8:15 a.m. to 12 noon.
5. Every Saturday will be a holiday for students.

PARENT TEACHER INTERACTION

1. It is compulsory for the parents to attend the PTM to assess their child's progress and performance. On the day of PTM, parents should adhere to the timings allotted. The student must accompany in school uniform only.
2. Parents can also meet teachers on first and third Saturday with prior appointment through school website only.

ALMANAC

1. Parents must ensure that their ward brings the Almanac to school daily.
2. Parents should communicate with the teachers to convey any information regarding their ward and vice-versa through the Almanac.
3. Almanac should be checked by parents every day for any note/circular/instruction and must be acknowledged by affixing their signature.
4. The students' personal record should be correctly and completely filled in the duplicate form. It is essential for parents to enter their signature in the aforesaid form.

UNIFORM

1. Kindly ensure strict adherence to the prescribed uniform and personal hygiene. We strictly prohibit stylish haircut.
2. It is mandatory for the students to wear Identity Card every day.

3. Track Suit to be worn during Games Period.
4. Taekwondo dress to be worn by Nursery children as per the time table.

BOOKS

To reduce bag load is our prime concern. The school has taken initiative to keep books and stationery in the school. Kindly label all the books and stationery with the permanent marker. One or two subjects study material will be sent home daily for practice and revision.

SPOKEN ENGLISH

English is the medium of instruction in the school. To develop maximum fluency in English, Student must converse in English at all times. Please encourage your child to speak in English even at home.

TRANSPORT

1. The students availing the school transports should reach the respective bus stop five minutes earlier than the stipulated time.
2. Parents should not board the bus and get into an argument with the driver/helper/student/teacher in charge.
3. Our buses have CCTV cameras and mobile connectivity. Phone numbers can be taken from the Transport In charge.
4. Parents should come/send a responsible person with parent I-Card to receive their ward from the bus stop failing which the child shall be brought back to school.
5. Parents who make private transport arrangements for their ward by hiring van/rickshaw, will be completely responsible to ensure that proper Police Verification of driver is done and all safety measures have been taken to avoid any untoward incident.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. The Newly admitted students should wear temporary Identity card given by the school, till they get their new I-Cards.
2. Parents must ensure that the child carries the napkin and a handkerchief to the school daily.
3. Children should be toilet trained. Many a times children tend to spoil their dress, therefore send an extra pair of clothes daily.
4. Refer Monthly Planner given on the School Website for activities and holidays.
5. Please visit the Parent Portal on the school website for regular updates.
6. Parents must register a permanent mobile phone number with the school on which SMS and other alerts may be sent. In case of change, the parent must notify the changed number in writing within 3 days.
7. Children will strictly not to be handed over to any unauthorized person. In case anyone other than the authorized person/cab driver is sent to collect child, the parents must immediately notify the school authorities, telephonically/by an e-mail, through Registered Phone Numbers/E-Mail Id only or a letter duly signed by parent, detailing his verification with Parent ID card.
8. The name, class and section of the student should be prominently marked on all the belongings of the student.
9. It is permissible for students to come in casuals on their birthday. Parents must ensure that they do not send more than one packet of toffees to celebrate their ward's birthday. Apart from this, anything else sent will not be accepted.
