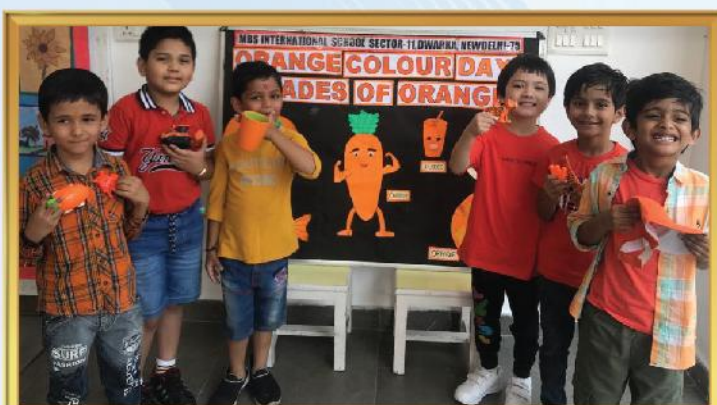
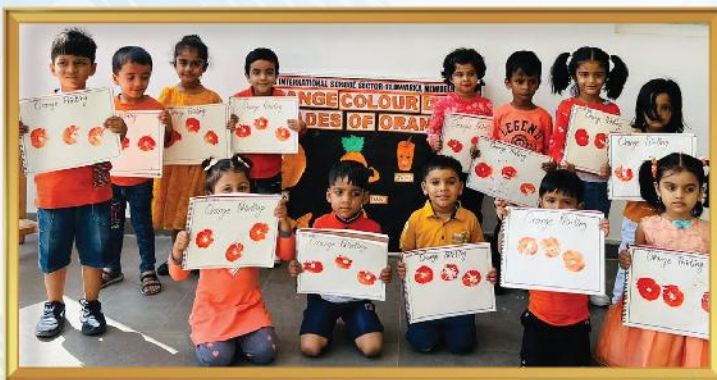
A Vibrant Journey Into The World Of Colour

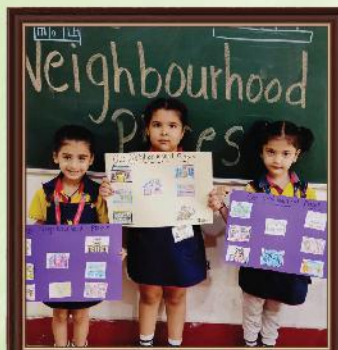
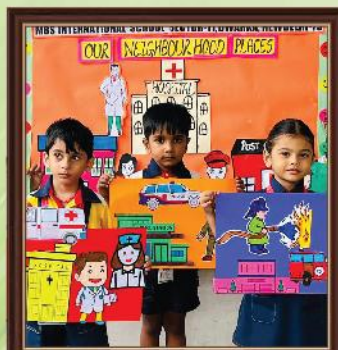
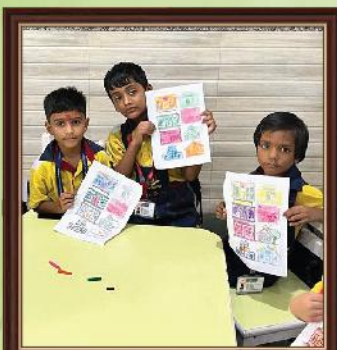


Exploring Our Neighbourhood

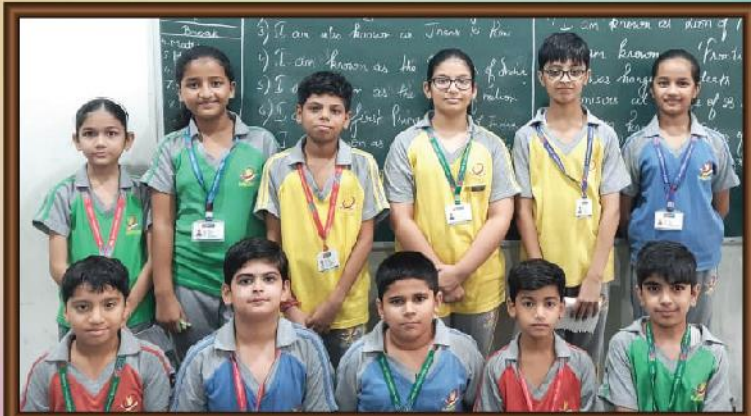
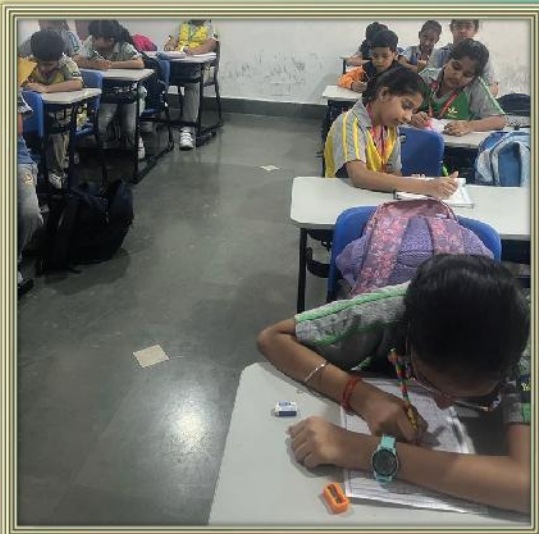

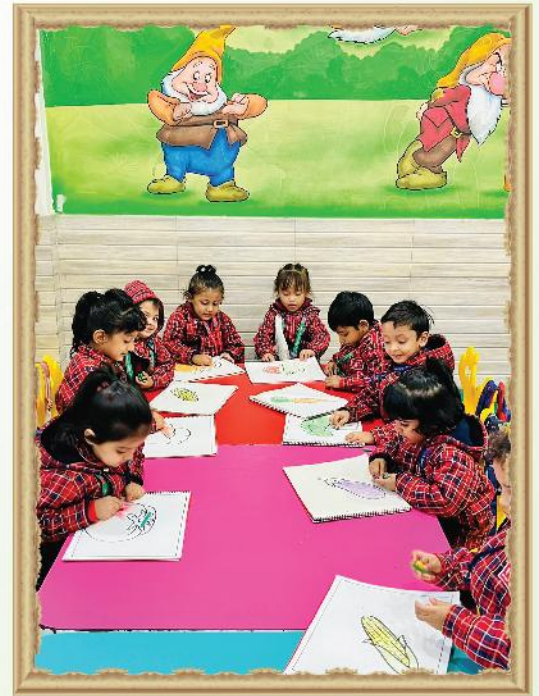


A Holistic Wellness Initiative

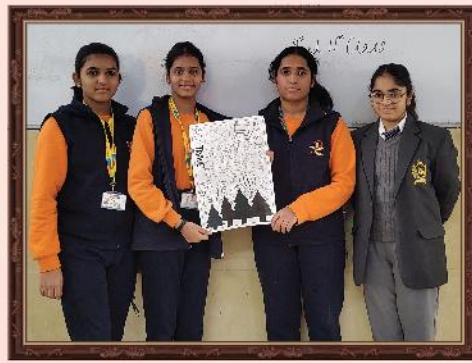
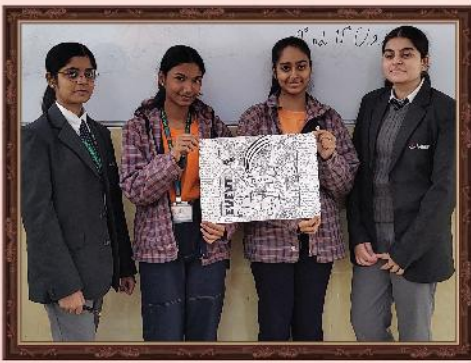

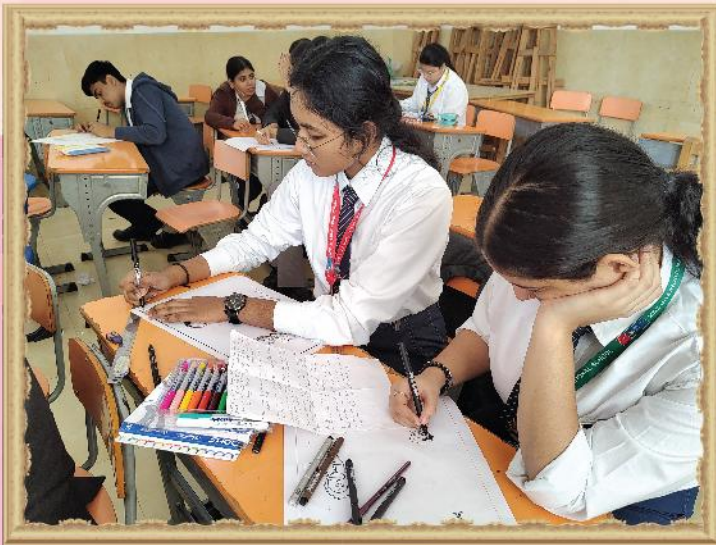

The School Orchestra mesmerised the audience with a captivating presentation, Symphony, skillfully coordinating each note and instrument.

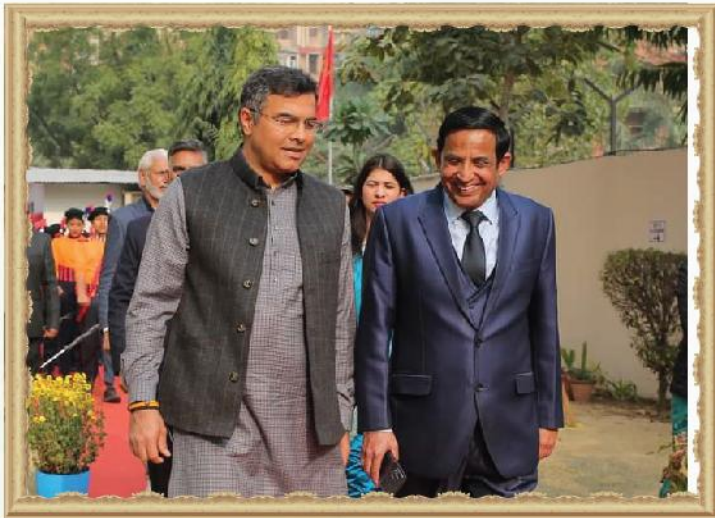

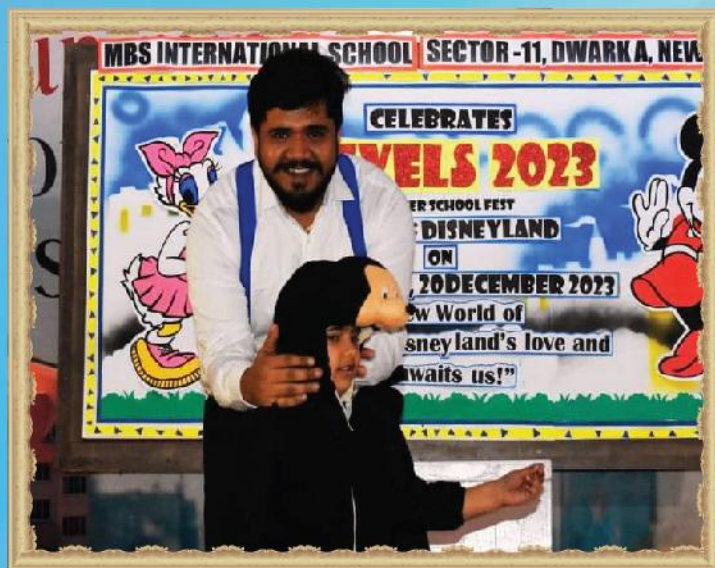
Revels 2023: A Magical Journey Into Literary And Creative Excellence

As the evening came to an end with the school song and a vote of thanks, it was evident that the event had left an indelible mark of friendship, joy, and treasured moments.





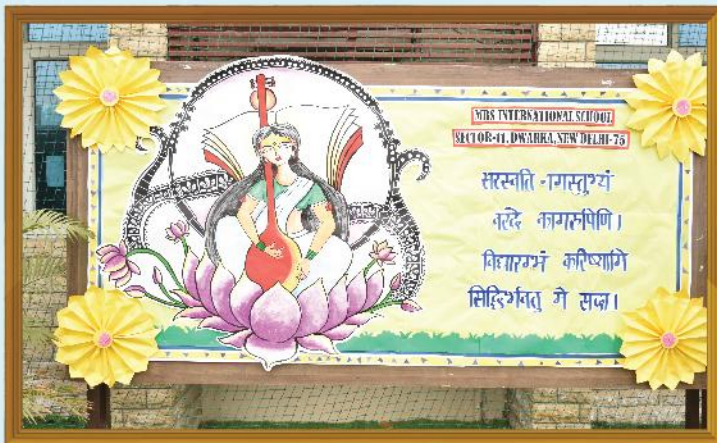
Vasantotsav: Celebrating The Arrival of Spring

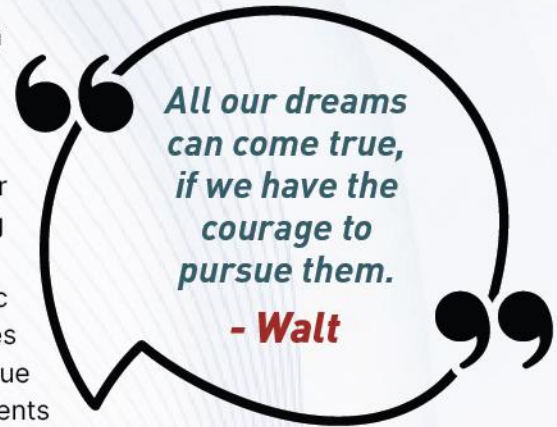




Kindling Imagination Through Storytelling

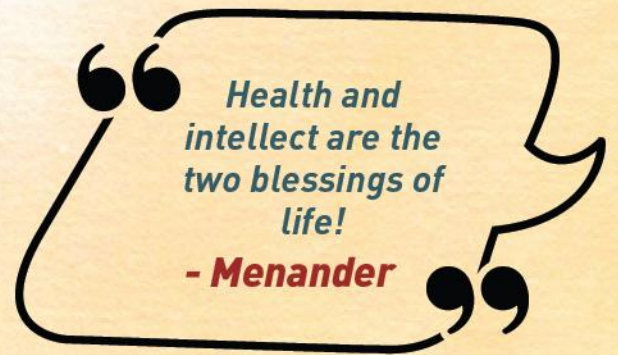


Head To Head Balloon Race – Concept Races

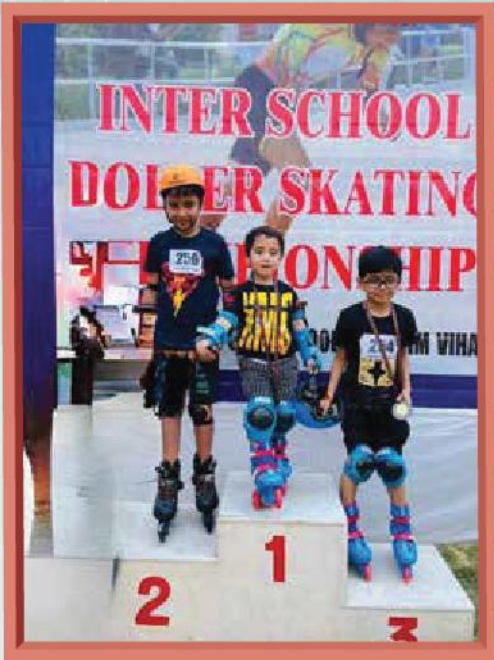
In the Adarsh Public School Open Table Tennis Tournament 2024, he secured the 3rd position in the U13 category, reaffirming his status as a rising star in the sport.

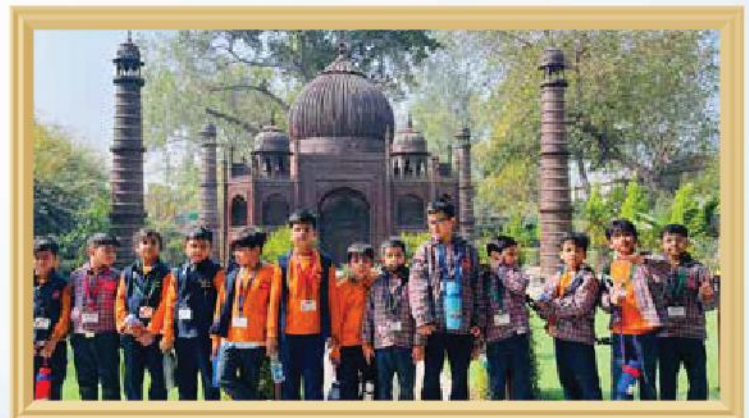
