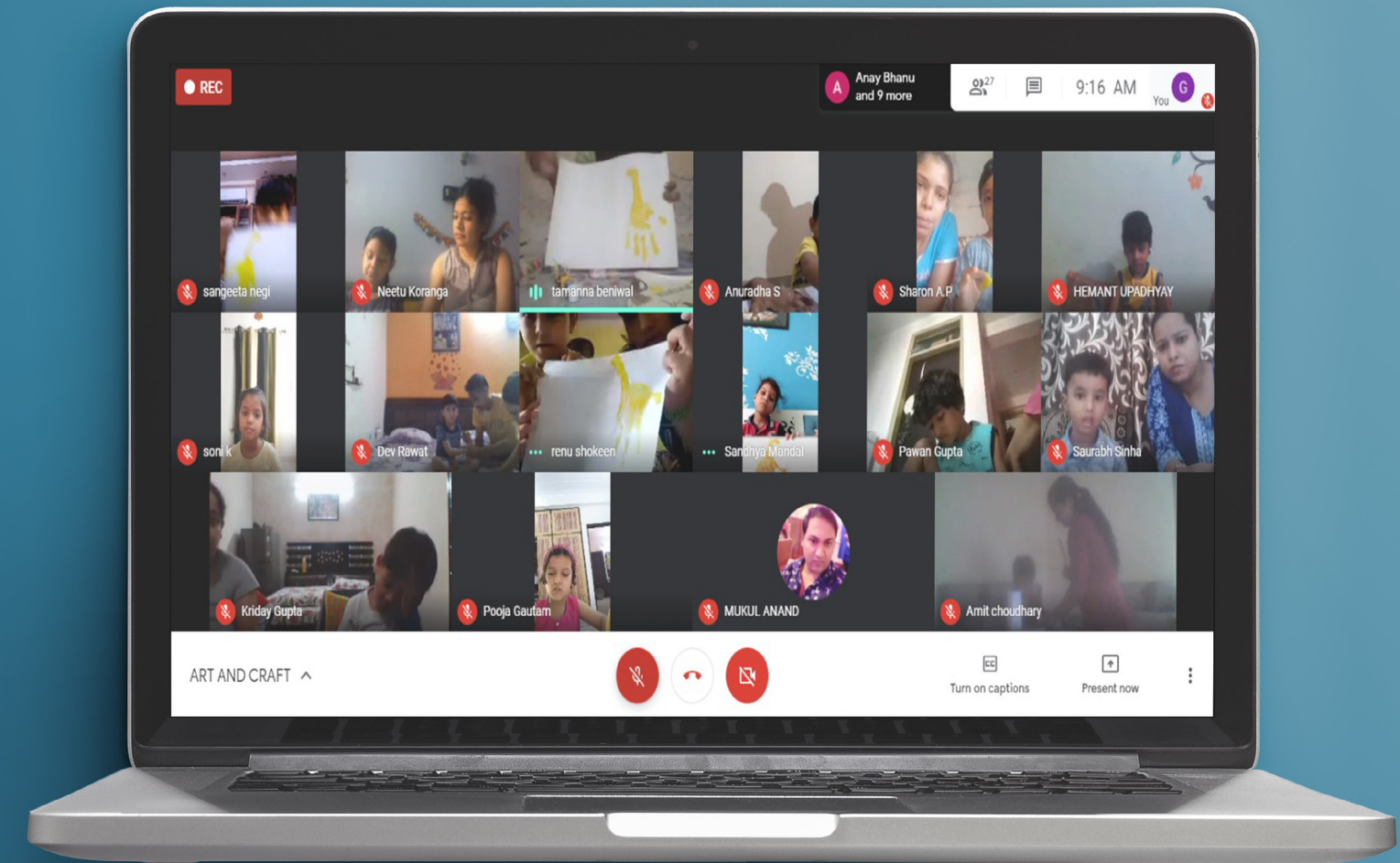
The assignments, reference material shared through Online learning portal have helped the students recapitulate and practice concepts in the comfort of their homes.

Food & Flavours- a culinary webinar

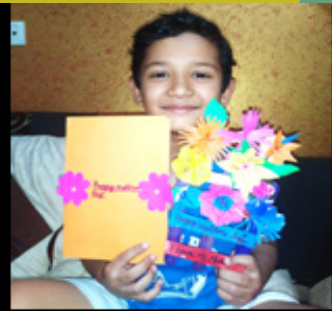




